Ministry Chair(s) Needed for 2008 NFCC Holiday Families

For the past two years, the Tracy family (Jacquie, Brad, Lauren, and Julia) has graciously given their time, talent, and treasure at St. David's for the North Fulton Community Charities (NFCC) Holiday Families program. This program helps our neighbors, who face many challenges throughout the year, have a nice Thanksgiving and Christmas holiday. St. David's Outreach for NFCC offers a prayer of thanksgiving for the Tracy family's leadership in this ministry for the past two years, and we are seeking a family or two who feel called to this ministry for 2008.

St. David's agrees to help approximately 40 families each year by providing \$40 in Kroger certificates (at Thanksgiving and Christmas), and by providing gifts for the families at Christmas time (3 requested items for each family member). The leaders of this ministry coordinate this program and communicate the needs to the parish. They also request volunteer support for staffing donation tables, preparing "angel" posters, and arranging for gift delivery to NFCC.

The Tracy family has provided an NFCC manual with month by month details, and they have samples for all of the activity/communications the ministry lead will need. They will be available for consultation for whomever volunteers for this important and fulfilling ministry. For Your Information

How to Make a Gift to The St. David's Endowment Fund

The choice of an appropriate planned gift vehicle usually provides significant tax advantages to the donor. Some of the most common are:

- Gift in Life: a gift of cash, securities, or other assets, such as objects of value or real estate.
- Bequest: provides for loved ones, the church, and others through a provision in your will.
- Life Insurance: allows a large gift at small cost by giving a new or existing policy or by designating the church as beneficiary of a policy.
- Charitable Remainder Trust, or Pooled Income Fund, or Charitable Gift Annuity: allows a donor to receive income for life while making a major gift to the church.
- Revocable Living Trust: allows a gift of assets to be made now while retaining the right to retrieve those assets later.
- Charitable lead Trust: allows a donor to give income to the church for a period of years but have the assets later returned to a family member or other beneficiary.
