The approximate meeting times are Friday, November 10, from 10 a.m. - 5 p.m. and Saturday, November 11, from 9 a.m. - 3 p.m. The meeting agenda includes addressing the business of the diocese and a program, topic to be determined.

1. you must be a confirmed communicant in good standing of the Parish,
2. who is a regular attendant at the services of the church, and
3. must be known by the Treasurer to have made and faithfully fulfilled, during the current year, a stated financial commitment for church support.

Call the parish office (770-993-6084) if you have any questions. The vestry will elect delegates and alternates from the pool of applicants later this summer.
