

## Jeffords Hall Update for the Week of August 27<sup>th</sup>

At the beginning of our building project a team of Parishioners that frequently use the kitchen was formed. This team has assisted in giving vital information to develop a kitchen space that would best serve the needs of St. David's. On Wednesday, August 29<sup>th</sup>, Father Paul, Jan Georges and members of the Kitchen Team toured the kitchen of the Temple located on Peachtree Street. This is a project that our Architects had designed and is close in size to our kitchen in Jeffords Hall. We were mainly interested in the functionality of the kitchen and it gave us a very clear understanding of the space.

On Thursday, August 30<sup>th</sup>, Father Paul and Jan Georges met with Scott Hall from our landscape architectural firm, AEC. Scott has created the landscape design for the Jeffords Hall project which will include a garden being donated by a Parishioner. Scott presented his drawings and we were able to determine where the Mary Garden will be located (viewed from the windows in Jeffords Hall).

We scheduled a preliminary meeting with the Financial team at the Diocese for September 21. Lance Patterson will submit our financial plan and all requested information from the Diocese. This meeting serves as time for Diocesan Financial Officers to review our information, ask questions and prepare us for the final proposal to the Diocese for approval of our financial plan for Jeffords Hall. Father Paul will be identifying a Treasurer who will only be dedicated to the Jeffords Hall funding/finances.

Our Staff and faithful volunteers are working on the final plans for our Parish Event on September 29<sup>th</sup> for Jeffords Hall. Please spread the word so we can have a big turnout for this fun event complete with great food, band and fun for the children.
