To prepare a box of mac and cheese you need a stove, a pot, milk, butter, and a bowl. To prepare a CUP of mac and cheese you need water and a microwave! Many of the NFCC clients live in circumstances which make the cup/microwave choice highly desirable. Single serve sizes are also used in the NFCC Emergency Bags, which are filled every day, for homeless clients.

- Vienna Sausages (or other single serve canned meats)
