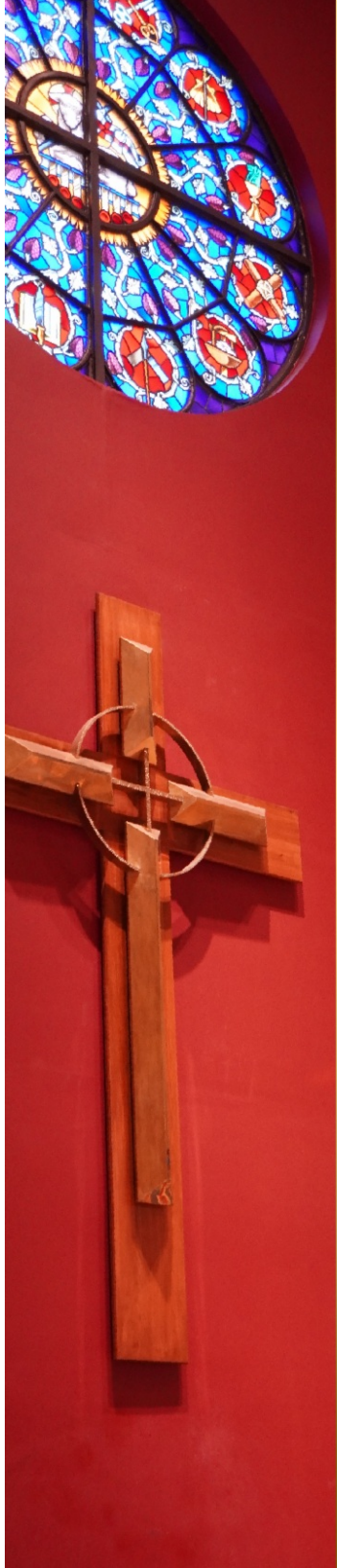

Valet parking will be available, as will childcare.

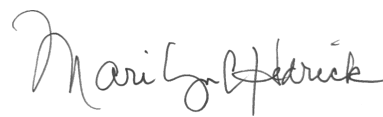
