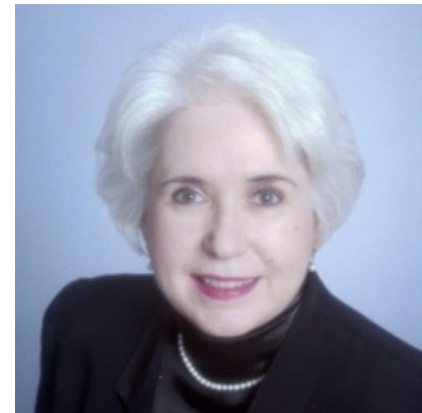

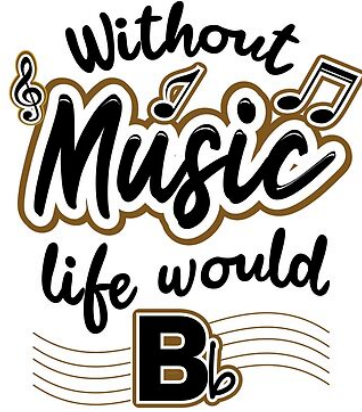

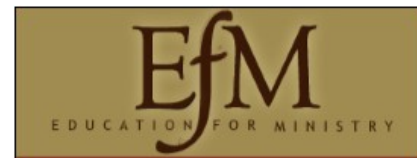

#### Class Openings

St. David's has proudly sponsored an Education for Ministry (EfM) program for the past 37 years and is one of the longest-running EfM programs in the Atlanta Diocese. The class is currently led by Steve and Betty Cunningham, who have a combined tenure of 25 years as certified EfM mentors at St. David's.

EfM is a four-year program sponsored by the School of Theology of the University of the South at Sewanee for adults who desire to take a deep dive into scripture, church history, and practical theology in a small-group study and discussion setting.

The next EfM class at St. David's will begin in September of this year and continue through mid-May of 2026. There are currently four openings for first-year students. ## Summer Choir Opportunities

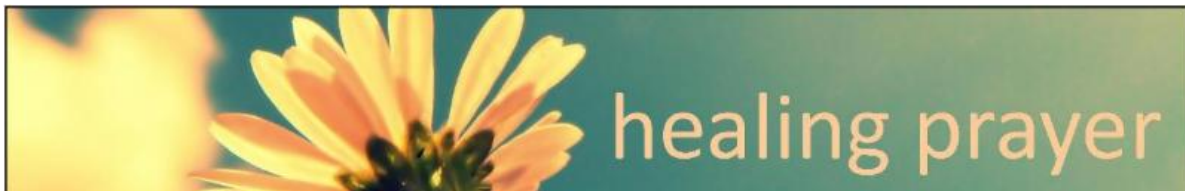
