St. David's Divorce Support Group By Marilyn Hedrick

Last January, St. David's organized and formed a Divorce Support Group. The idea for this group sprang into my mind at the Women's Retreat. After talking to Remington, I started planning while he found me the resource I needed: The Rebuilding Workbook. The first session was held on Sunday, February 20th at the church and continued through May 22nd. Over refreshments, we discussed such topics as loneliness, grief, anger, self-worth, forgiveness, \ and intimacy. The six members' situations were all different, but each wanted to rise above the trauma to a new life where relationships to others and God were healthier.

Here are some testimonies from members of the group.

"The new divorce group at St. David's was a lifeline in a dark and difficult time in my life. To be with other church members going through similar experiences helped me feel less alone and to have it led by Marilyn, who was already on the other side, gave me hope and assurance. This group made the church an actual help in a hard time."

"The divorce group was something I looked forward to each week. Even more than a year post-divorce, I found this community of women such a beautiful, welcoming, uplifting, and safe space in which to confront old hurts, share common experiences, and build connections. These women helped me take the next steps in healing and reminded me of the love and laughter God surrounds us with exactly when we need it."

Once the course itself concluded, this group decided to stay together, forming a "Covenant Group" We ask that you pray for their continued growth and happiness. Having been divorced for 35 years myself, I learned so much, grew, and experienced forgiveness of myself and my former husband not even realizing that I was still hanging on to some old hurts.
