Each Sunday, after the opening prayers, children ages 4-years-old to 5th grade are invited to join our amazing team of youth and adult leaders to go to Children's Chapel. Children separate into 2 groups by age/grade for their chapel time. However, there is always flexibility for children to join in with either group if that works better for the child. Children return at the Peace.

Activities: Prayers, stories, crafts, check-ins and listening to other children. We play, sing, and pray together as we share God's love in the world around us.
