



## **Covid -19 Safety Protocols**

We NEED Reservations for all services, both INDOORS AND OUTDOORS. Reservations give us a contact list in the event of a covid outbreak and is required by the diocese.

### **To make reservations**

- Please email [jan@stdavidchurch.org](mailto:jan@stdavidchurch.org)
- List how many people are attending and which service you would like to attend. (8am, 10:30 indoor and 10:30 outdoor).
- You will receive a return email stating your seat/chair numbers.
- Reservations are open Sunday through Friday, closing at 4pm. (for example if you are attending the 5/23 service you can make a reservation starting on Sunday 5/16 through Friday 5/21)
- If you are comfortable sitting with a “pod” – (a pod is a small group that has contact with each other essentially exclusively and practices social distancing) when making reservations state the people in your pod and you will be seated together – This enables us to seat more people in the nave.

### **What to Expect at Indoor Worship**

#### *When you enter the Church building, what should you expect?*

- Masks are required to be worn at all times at the Church campus/buildings.
- You will stop at a greeter station to confirm information and move on to worship space as quickly as possible! Please use social distancing of 6 ft. while waiting.
- Your name will be shown as attending on our contact list. A contact list is required in the event of exposure to the virus so that you can be notified.

- Automatic hand sanitizer stations will be provided and required to be used upon entry to Church building.
- All participants will self-check temperature before coming to church
- One-way traffic flow will be required after you enter the building.
- Between services, we will disinfect with an electrostatic sprayer with hospital grade disinfectant.

*When you enter worship space:*

- An usher will seat you and the ushers will dismiss by row.
- A box will be provided where you can drop in collection, a sanitation station will be provided.
- Passing the peace and shaking hands will be delayed.
- After dismissal, do not gather in the Church building, proceed to outdoors if you desire to visit with your masks on and within social distancing guideline of 6 ft.
- If you become infected with the virus after being in the Church building, please contact Rebecca Cline, Parish Administrator at 770-993-6084, ext. 104, as soon as possible so that we can use our contact list to advise those who were in attendance. **Names of those who are ill will remain confidential.**
- Virtual services will continue.

## What to Expect at Outdoor Worship

- All participants will need to arrive on time.
- All participants must wear a face mask.
- Automatic hand sanitizer stations will be provided and required to be used upon entry to the outdoor service.
- Your name will be shown as attending on our contact list. A contact list is required in the event of exposure to the virus so that you can be notified.
- If you become infected with the virus after being at an outdoor service, please contact Rebecca Cline (770-993-1094, ext. 104) as soon as possible so that we can use our contact list to advise those who were in attendance. **Names of those that are ill will remain anonymous..**
